ORDINANCE NO: 5-2026-26

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE BUTTERNUT FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT FOR SERVICES PROVIDED/RENDERED FOR THE TOWN OF AGENDA.

WHEREAS, the Town of Chippewa, Town of Agenda, and the Village of Butternut, desire to enter into that certain Fire Protection Agreement creating the Butternut Fire Protection District (the "Fire Protection District"); and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Agenda, pursuant to Wis. Stats. sec. 66.0301 and 60.55, has the authority to enter into a joint fire department with another town, village, or city;

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Agenda has determined it to be in the public interest to enter into the Fire Protection District.

THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF AGENDA, COUNTY OF ASHLAND, STATE OF WISCONSIN, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The Fire Protection Agreement is approved, and the Town Chairperson, or his or her designee, shall sign and do all things reasonably necessary or appropriate to enter into the Fire Protection District.

SECTION 2: All references to the Butternut Volunteer Fire Department, Inc. in the Town of Agenda Ordinances are hereby rescinded.

SECTION 3: Pursuant to the Fire Protection Agreement, fire prevention inspections shall be conducted at least once per calendar year, provided that the interval between said inspections does not exceed fifteen (15) months.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval by the Town Board and posting as required by Wisconsin Law.
